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The F150 made its debut in 1975 for the 1976 model year, as part of the sixth generation of the FSeries. Ford designed the F150 specifically to meet upcoming federal emissions requirements. Since the F100, which was also in production at the time, was often referred to as a halfton pickup, the F150 became unofficially known as a heavy halfton pickup. That year, the FSeries became the bestselling truck in the U.S., and it would go on to become the bestselling vehicle in the U.S. for more than 20 years, as well as the bestselling truck for more than 30 years. Currently in its seventh generation the 12th generation overall for the FSeries, the F150 straddles the line between daily commuter and lightduty work truck. It sits on a highstrength hydroformed chassis and delivers a carlike ride and handling, yet offers impressive towing capacity of between 10,400 and 17,100 pounds, depending on the engine and drivetrain configuration. Inside, features like the Ford Sync communications system give the cabin a hightech feel. Its expected to be the more fuel efficient of the two.The powerplants drive the various F150 trucks through two available transmissions and either rearwheel or fourwheeldrive configurations. In addition, buyers can chose from Regular Cab, SuperCab, and SuperCrew body styles, as well as three bed lengths of 5.5, 6.5, and 8 feet. Despite a number of improvements to the chassis, some still find the ride too harsh, especially over rough roads. Ford has gone to great lengths to give the cabin a more carlike feel, with aboveaverage fit and finish, and a relatively quiet driving experience for passengers. However, Ford continues to

tweak the F150 lineup with engine, feature, and trim updates to meet the needs and interests of a wide range of buyers. Buyers can expect the F150 to pick up the slack, which explains the arrival of the more fuelefficient V6 engines for lowend trims. Rumors of a diesel powerplant for the F150 remain unfounded, but potential buyers can expect Ford to continue to develop more efficient powerplants in the coming years, as the automaker attempts to strike a delicate balance between fuel economy and the high levels of performance buyers expect from the countrys topselling pickup truck. Dating back to the mid1940s, the FSeries established itself as a workhorse as well as a cultural icon. By the sixth generation, when the F150 debuted, the FSeries came in a wide range of trims and configurations, powered by an equally wide range of V6 and V8 engines. In addition, the FSeries was built in a number of plants in the U.S., as well as plants in Canada, Mexico, and Argentina. It quickly became popular with farmers and ranchers, as well as offroaders, and accounted for onethird of FSeries sales in its first year. Body styles included a twodoor cab, fourdoor crewcab, and fourdoor supercab, while available engines included a 130hp, 5.0liter Windsor V8 and a 200hp, 7.5liter 385 V8, as well as a 5.8liter FE V8 and a 3.9liter straight6. Also in 78, Ford added a 169hp Cleveland V8 to the range of available engines. Outside, the F150 displayed an aluminumbar grille and round headlights with black accents, although the Lariat trim featured rectangular headlights when it debuted. The F150s exterior displayed a square shape in the front end, with flat panels and sharply creased edges. A new fourspeed automatic joined the options list, and fourwheeldrive 4WD trims featured a new independent front suspension. Engine choices included the Windsor V8, the Cleveland V8, and a 165hp, 4.9liter straight6. As a result, the new F150 trim lineup for 82 included the XL, XLS, XLT Lariat, and Explorer.

Also in 82, the F150 displayed a new front grille equipped with the blue Ford oval logo, making its first appearance on the FSeries trucks. A total of 15 engines, including a new 110hp Essex V6 and a 245hp 385 V8, powered the FSeries. For the 1984 model year, Ford discontinued the F100, making the F150 the entrylevel truck in the FSeries lineup. In 1985, Ford offered the F150 with an optional fuelinjected 5.0liter Windsor V8 engine, making the F150 the first FSeries truck equipped with a fuelinjected engine. Rear antilock brakes became a standard feature, making the F150 and the entire FSeries the first trucks with this type of safety equipment. F150 trims included the XL, XLT, and XLT Lariat, with twodoor, extended cab, and supercab body styles. Buyers could also equip the F150 with an available fivespeed transmission in 88. However, the technology was not extended to other FSeries trucks until 1991, demonstrating the important position the F150 held in the automakers lineup. In addition, Ford reintroduced the F150 with a flareside bed, which placed the rear wheel wells outside the bed, rather than inside. It was a look that helped distinguish the first three generations of the FSeries, and gave the F150 a hunkier, retro look. The interior received a new dashboard, among other features, while trims again included the XL, XLT, and XLT Lariat, in twodoor and fourdoor body styles, with short or long beds. Ford also added a new 195hp turbodiesel V8 to the engine lineup. Power came from a 240hp, 5.8liter V8 engine. A year later, in 1994, Ford added a driversside airbag and CFCfree air conditioning as standard features for certain trims, while a CD player, remote keyless entry, and a poweradjustable drivers seat were among the options. For 1995, Ford offered the F150 in an upscale Eddie Bauer trim, which replaced the XLT Lariat trim. In fact, the 10th generation represented the FSeries first full redesign since 1980.

Uncertain if the new appearance and plusher interiors would appeal to dedicated truck buyers, Ford continued to sell the ninthgeneration FSeries into the 97 model year. However, buyers took readily to the new F150, and Motor Trend named it the Truck of the Year. Other trim levels included

Standard, XL, and XLT. Engine choices included a 4.2liter Essex V6, a 4.6liter Triton V8, and a 235hp, 5.4liter Triton V8. Despite the accolades it received, the F150 did not perform well in safety tests, causing the IIHS to saddle it with a Poor rating for protecting passengers during frontal accidents, and placing the F150 near the bottom of some safetyoriented lists. A SuperCrew body style, with four fullsize doors, rolled into showrooms in 2001. For the first time, all cabs had four doors, with the Regular cabs receiving rearhinged halfdoors. The SuperCrew retained its four full doors. Fourwheel antilock brakes came standard. XL, STX, XLT, FX4, and Lariat trims were available. Ford also continued to offer a limitededition version of the previousgenerations F150, called the Heritage, which included an updated grille. A Foose Edition, based on the FX2 Sport, debuted in 2008, and a new highend Platinum trim came along in 2009. In addition, in 09 Ford updated the F150s frame to make it lighter and more rigid, and the current 12thgeneration F150 debuted at the North American International Auto Show in Detroit. In 1997, for instance, Ford offered the F150 in no less than 51 different configurations, and for more than three decades the F150 was the bestselling truck in America. If you extrapolate the numbers, you can quickly see the vast number of choices available to prospective F150 buyers. The 11th generation received a new platform, which resulted in more spacious cabs. In addition, all trims offered the convenience of four doors, as well as the aerodynamic exterior lines introduced with the 10th generation.

In the safety department, fourwheel antilock brakes became a standard feature for the 11th generation. On the other hand, the 1997 F150 was awarded Truck of the Year by Motor Trend, and added such trims as the Harley Davidson and the King Ranch to the F150 lineup, making trucks from this generation well worth a look. Ford also equips its latemodel F150s with its Sync communications system, which gives the cabs a hightech feel. These trims offer unique opportunities for buyers. On the other hand, those seeking something other than fully decked out F150s should have no problems finding plenty of solid, dependable entrylevel XL and XLT trims, including those from the trucks earliest generations, which continue to make good buys.
